

# Local Scholarships

2019 - 77 students were awarded \$109,258

## STUDENTS MAY APPLY FOR LOCAL SCHOLARSHIPS IN APRIL THE YEAR THEY GRADUATE

**To be eligible to apply for and receive a local scholarship to be used at any institute of higher learning students must meet the following criteria:**

- 1 - Graduate from Morgan High School
- 2 - Have taken 8 advanced classes during their senior year (A, B and C sections count as separate classes)  
*Advanced classes include all English, Math, Science, Social Studies, AP, Concurrent Enrollment, DTC and IVC and World Language classes.*
- 3 - Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or a senior GPA of 3.2
- 4 - Have taken the ACT
- 5 - Be eligible for extra-curricular activities

**The current cap for local scholarships is \$3,000.00**

Students who accept scholarships from the educational institution they plan to attend for less than \$3,000.00 during their first year may apply for a local scholarship. The student may be awarded a local scholarship so that the combined total of the scholarships does not exceed \$3,000.00.

*All students who meet the criteria can apply for  
"Distinct Local Scholarships" regardless of other scholarships they accept*

**To accept a local scholarship students must:**

- 1 - Attend the Scholarship Awards Night held in May.
- 2 - Send a thank-you letter to the person or business providing the scholarship.
- 3 - Email your college schedule and college Student ID# to [audrey.peterson@morgansd.org](mailto:audrey.peterson@morgansd.org) or drop it off at the District Office. Payment will be sent directly to the institution.
